Malta

Malta is a true Mediterranean marvel. Heavily influenced by the many civilisations which have contested and ruled its sun-filled shores, Malta and Gozo, its sister island, together claim over 6,500 years of history with one of the world's greatest concentrations of historical sights. Each conquering power has left its mark from Arabic town names to British food, Greek superstitions and Roman Catholicism. The number of well-preserved megalithic ruins scattered throughout the Maltese archipelago will astound even the most seasoned traveller. A wander through remarkable ancient sites such as the hypogeum of Hal Saflieni, or the temples at Hagar Qim and Mnajdra will leave you pondering the ingenuity of early Stone Age civilisations.

Follow in the Footsteps of Knights

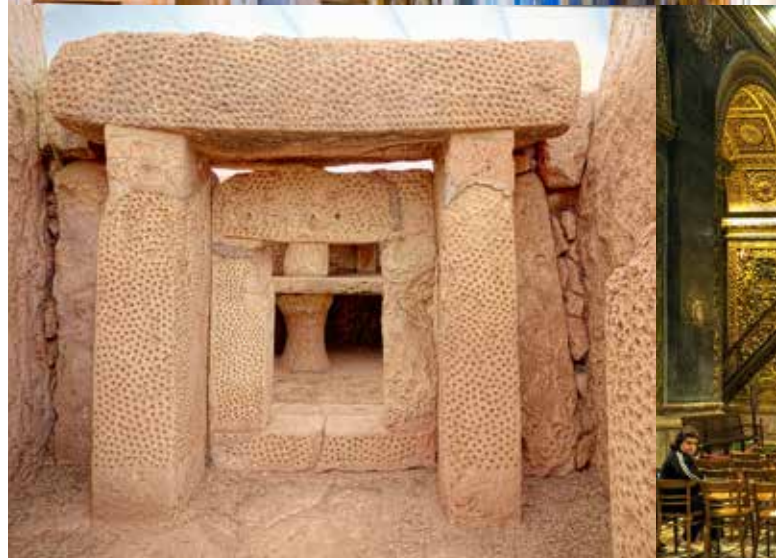
For almost 300 years, Malta served as headquarters for the medieval Knights Hospitaller, also known as the Order of St John. Its vibrant capital - Valletta - brims with treasures from this era including the St John's Co-Cathedral, filled with priceless Baroque masterpieces, and the Grandmaster's Palace, which houses an impressive collection of armour and weapons.

Privately Cruise the Maltese Archipelago

Navigate the stunning Maltese archipelago in a private yacht, stopping in secluded bays where you can snorkel or swim in crystalline waters. Admire the spectacular rocky coastlines of Comino - an island that features in many Hollywood blockbuster films. 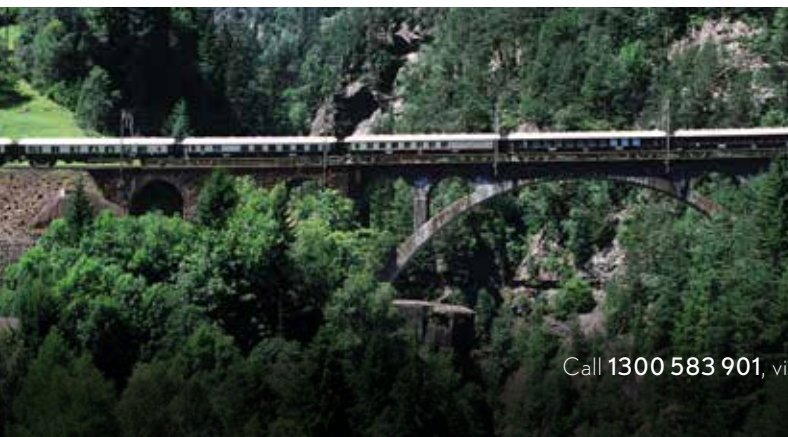

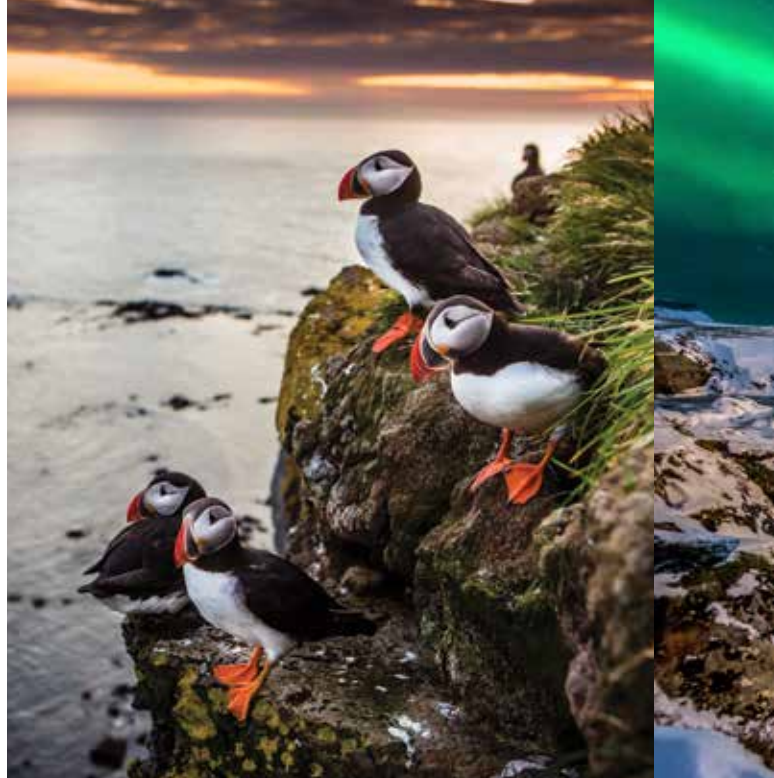
