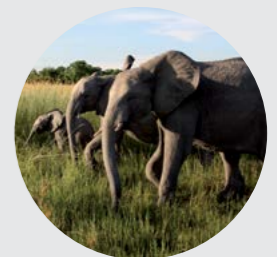
Your vehicle

Our purpose-built vehicles have been designed for tough African conditions and plenty of game viewing, with everything you need included – right down to folding camp chairs. But don't expect Africa to be your traditional touring experience. While it's our aim to avoid them, the occasional breakdown or wet weather re-route can happen – they're best treated as all part of the journey.



Your accommodation

The accommodation you stay in depends on the style of overland adventure you choose. Sometimes you'll stay at campsites, hotels or lodges, while other times you'll pitch your tent in the bush, roughing it a little in order to experience the immense beauty of Africa up close. Our tents are slightly larger than the average two-person tent, and come with built-in mosquito screens.

Overlanding is an exciting way to make your journey across vast and varied landscapes as much a part of the adventure as the destination. You'll experience life in isolated communities, camp under starry African skies and see the Big Five – buffalo, rhinos, leopards, elephants and lions – in the company of a small group of like-minded travellers.

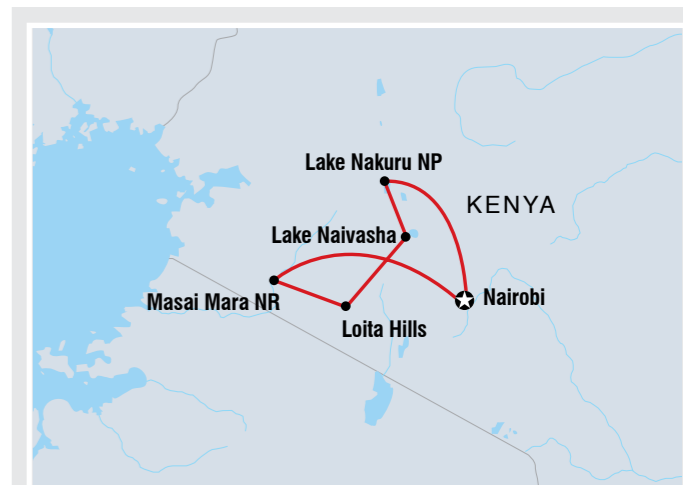

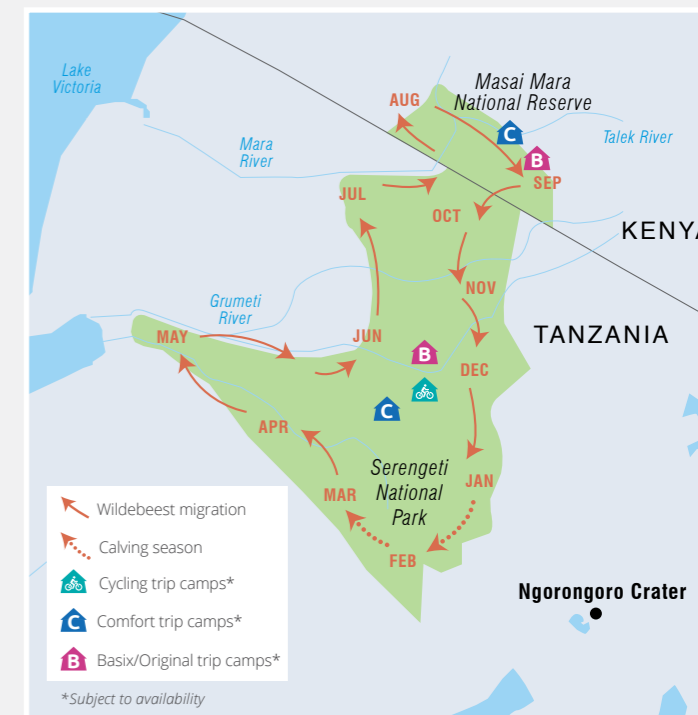

EAST AFRICA GREAT MIGRATION MAP

The map opposite gives a general indication of where herds migrate during the year. It also features some of the campsites you may visit on our Basix, Original, Comfort and Cycling trips.

Each year, the great migration of nearly two million wildebeest, zebras and gazelles – driven north and back again by shifts in rainfall – turns the plains of the Serengeti and Masai Mara into a theatre like no other. This phenomenon is part of an annual cycle in the region, and can be seen year-round as herds move in a constant clockwise circle. The calving season takes place in the southern Serengeti between January and mid-March, before the migration starts to head west in June. Herds tend to arrive in the Masai Mara in August and remain until November. It's important to note that this is a guide only, as no year is exactly the same as the last.

Gorilla Trekking

WHAT TO KNOW

We trek in search of gorillas in Rwanda's Volcanoes National Park and in Uganda's Bwindi Impenetrable National Park. The trekking can be wet and muddy – this is the rainforest after all – but your efforts will make the experience all the more special. See intrepidtravel.com/gorilla-trekking to find out more.



You don't need to be an athlete, but you do need to come prepared to hike up and down hills. If you're worried about your fitness, perhaps hire a porter to carry your bag and help you up the steep parts.



You'll be accompanied on your trek by expert local guides and rangers who'll brief you on what to expect and how to act around the gorillas.



Gorilla trekking is best between January–February and June–September. However, the low seasons benefit from fewer tourists and permits are easier to get.



Once you've reached a gorilla family, you'll have one unforgettable hour with them. You'll be able to watch the family as they go about their routines of feeding, preening, playing and snoozing.



Can't imagine one hour will be enough? There is the option to purchase a permit for another day's trekking – advanced booking is recommended.



Only eight permits are issued per group, so the time you spend with the gorillas is sure to be special. No other groups will be around while you're with them.



The location of gorilla families is constantly monitored to ensure you have the best chance of finding them. Expert local trackers set out each morning to radio a location to your guide.

WHAT TO PACK

- ✔ **Comfortable boots or trainers:** You'll be walking for a while, so pick some comfortable shoes that you don't mind getting wet and muddy.
- ✔ **Long pants and shirts:** It's best not to expose too much skin during the trek. Wear long sleeves and tuck your trousers into your socks to prevent safari ants from getting in.
- ✔ **A light rain jacket:** Bwindi and Volcanoes National Park are both tropical rainforests, so there's a good chance of rain year-round.
- ✔ **A pair of gardening gloves:** Sounds weird, but they'll stop your hands from getting scratched when grabbing branches and vines.
- ✔ **Insect repellent:** Alongside the gorillas and other animals, the jungle is home to many creepy crawlies, so make sure you enjoy this trek scratch-free.
- ✔ **Extra batteries:** The trackers can't guarantee how long you'll spend trekking before you encounter the gorillas. Make sure you bring spare camera batteries to last the full day.
- ✔ **Water:** It can get hot and humid in the mountains. Bring along a bottle of water – preferably a reusable bottle.
- ✔ **Energy snacks:** The trekking can be tough. Pack a few snacks like chocolate or muesli bars to help you power through.
