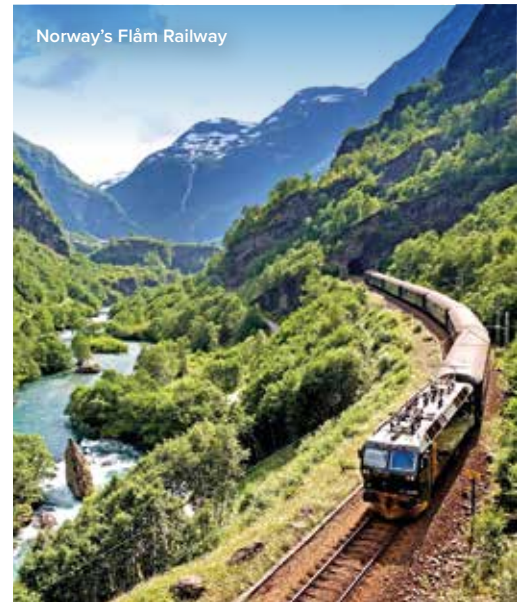
Known as the world's slowest express, this bright red train meanders through the Swiss Alps, between St Moritz and Zermatt, navigating 91 tunnels, 291 bridges and the 2,000-metre-high Oberalp Pass. With some of the world's most incredible landscapes and mountains outside your window, it's a bonus that the journey takes longer than expected.

JUNGFRAU RAILWAY >

If you've always dreamed of reaching great heights, Switzerland's Jungfrau Railway is your ticket. This cogwheel line takes its passengers to the Jungfraujoch, Europe's highest railway station, which is over 3,400 metres above sea level.

ZUGSPITZE RAILWAY >

Reach the summit of Germany's highest mountain, the Zugspitze, aboard this historic rack railway. Picturesque mountains, alpine forests and glaciers that shimmer like cut glass – this railway is one of Germany's most spectacular.

BERNINA EXPRESS >

Completed in 1897, the Kyle Line will take you from Scotland's east to west. The final leg, between Stromeferry and Kyle of Lochalsh, required 31 cuttings and 29 tunnels, all carved through solid rock; an incredible engineering feat for its time.
