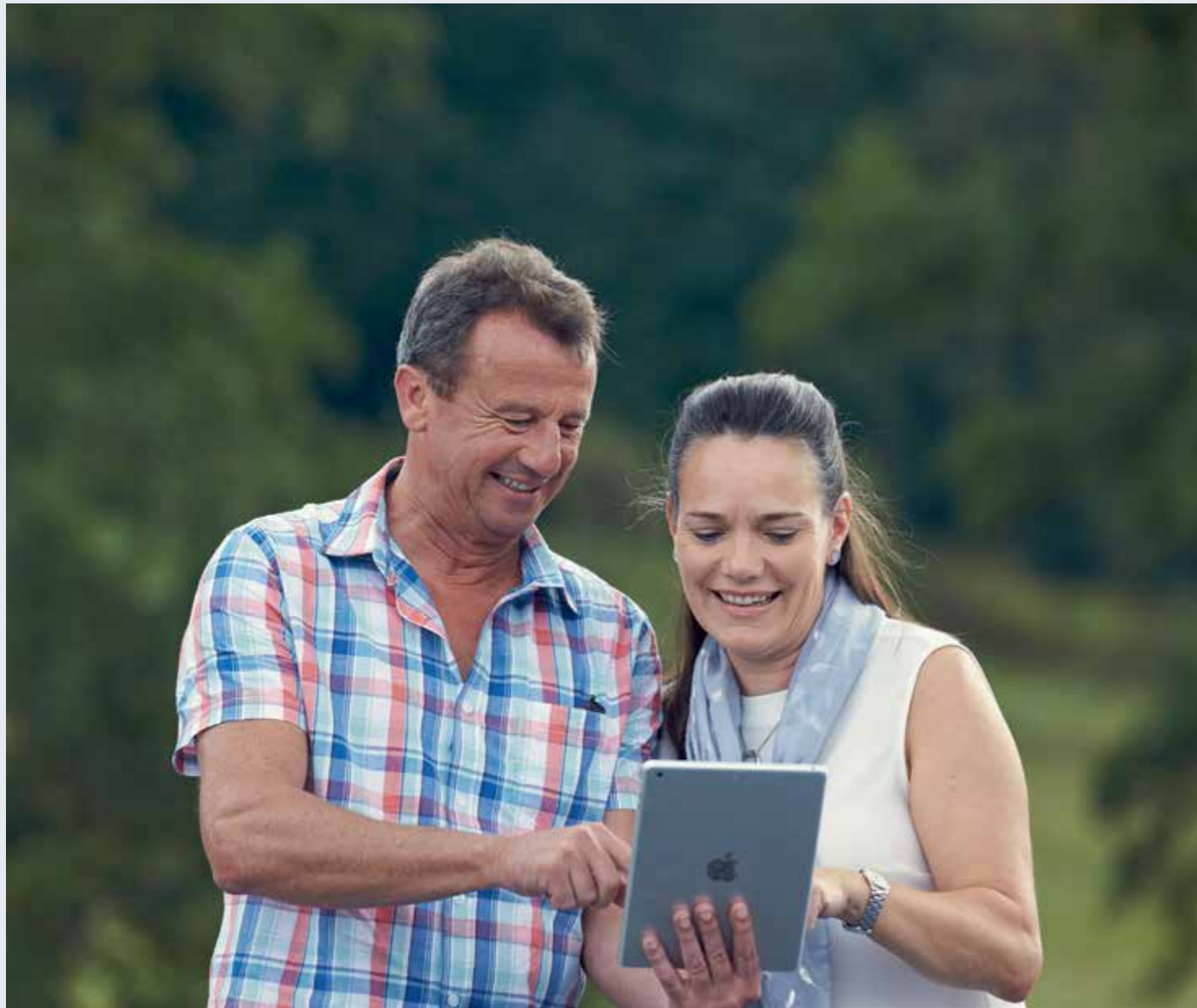
## THE GAME-SPOTTING FUN CONTINUES

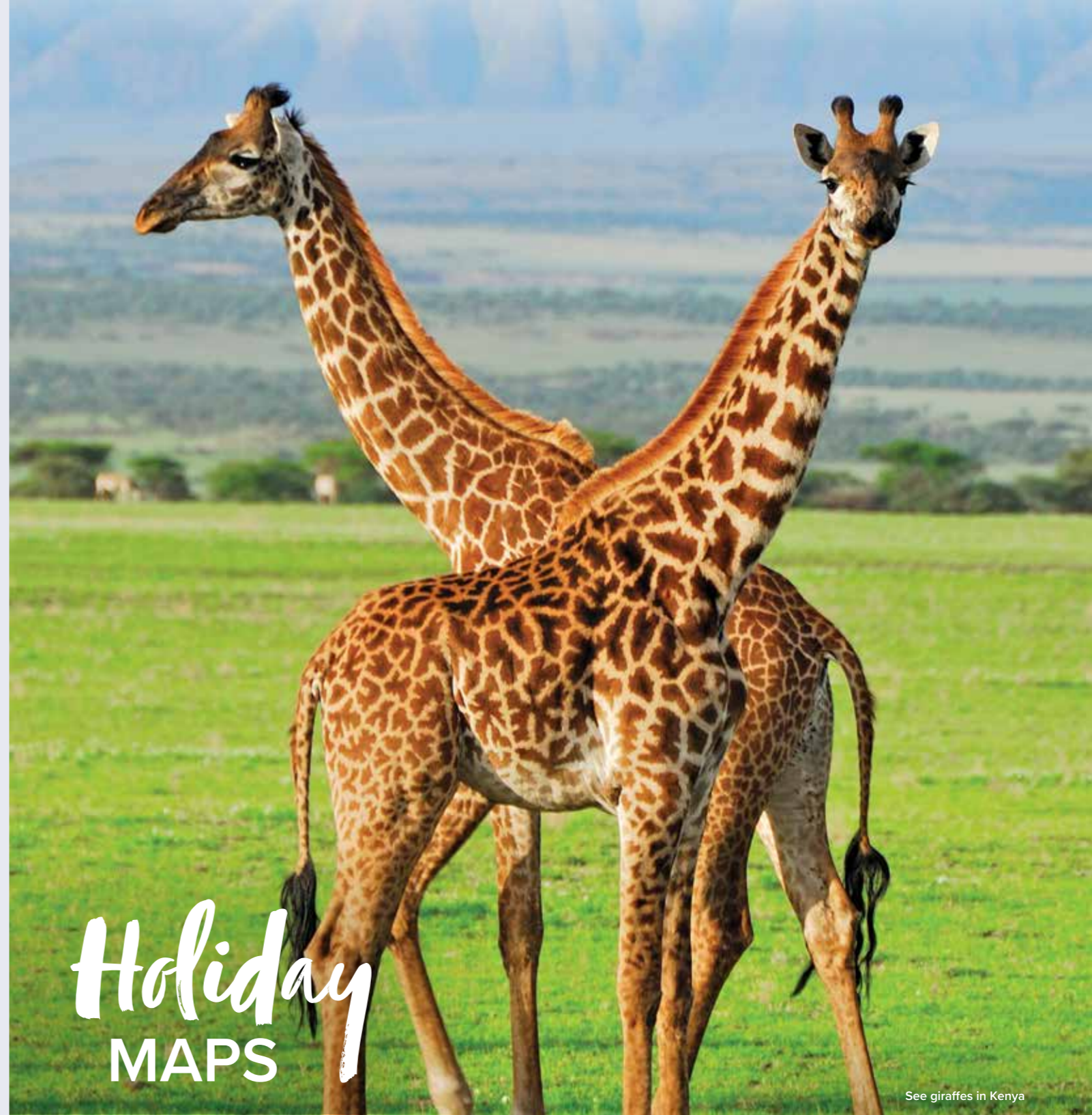

**Day 1. Arrive Cape Town** Arrive in Cape Town and transfer to your hotel, located close to the V&A Waterfront precinct. Later, meet fellow guests and your Tour Director at a Welcome Reception. **Three Nights:** Cape Town, Southern Sun Waterfront Hotel.

**Day 2. Cape Town** Explore Cape Town and ride the cable way up to Table Mountain's summit. Then, embark on an informative guided tour of the city before a free afternoon. Perhaps take a ferry to Robben Island, join an African Heritage Tour or visit the Constantia Wine Valley. **Tonight,** try your hand at African drumming, before indulging in a Welcome Dinner of Cape Malay cuisine. **BD**

**Day 3. Cape Town, Cape Peninsula** Discover the Cape Peninsula during a full-day tour. Take a scenic journey along Chapman's Peak Drive to Cape Point. Enjoy a light lunch before watching the penguins at Boulders Beach. Then, stop in historic Simon's Town. This evening is free for you to explore the V&A Waterfront. **BL**

**Day 4. Cape Town, Oudtshoorn** Travel to the Karoo region and see a well-preserved semi desert ecosystem. Arrive at your hotel for a delicious dinner of local produce, including ostrich. **Stay:** Oudtshoorn, Surval Boutique Olive Estate. **BD**

**Day 6. Knysna, Featherbed Nature Reserve** Perhaps join an optional boat tour from Plettenberg Bay to view dolphins (Apr-May) or whales (Jun-Oct) and other wildlife. Visit Featherbed Nature Reserve, a slice of paradise on the Western Head of Knysna, accessible only by ferry. Later, join a park guide for a 4WD journey to the top of Western Head. After, perhaps join

an optional bushwalk into ancient sea caves (own expense). **B**

**Day 7. Knysna, Port Elizabeth** Depart Knysna and continue your drive along the Garden Route. Visit Monkeyland Primate Reserve, the world's first free-roaming, multi-species primate sanctuary. Continue along the Storms River Mouth and through Tsitsikamma Forest on the way to Port Elizabeth. Check in to your hotel and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure. **Stay:** Port Elizabeth, Boardwalk Hotel. **B**

**Day 8. Port Elizabeth, Johannesburg, Kruger National Park** Board an included flight to Nelspruit via Johannesburg, then travel to Shishangeni Private Lodge, where you will stay for the next two nights in your own thatched chalet with a private game-viewing deck. Embark on your first game drive through the lodge's private concession. Enjoy sundowners amid the African bush before dinner back at your lodge. **Two Nights:** Kruger National Park, Shishangeni Private Lodge. **BLD**

**Day 9. Kruger National Park** A morning game drive offers the chance to track down Africa's Big Five, along with a host of other animals. Relish an authentic outdoor boma dinner tonight. **BLD**

**Day 10. Kruger National Park, Johannesburg** Take an early morning game drive before you fly back to Johannesburg.

Enjoy your evening at leisure. **Stay:** Johannesburg, Peermont Mondior. **B**

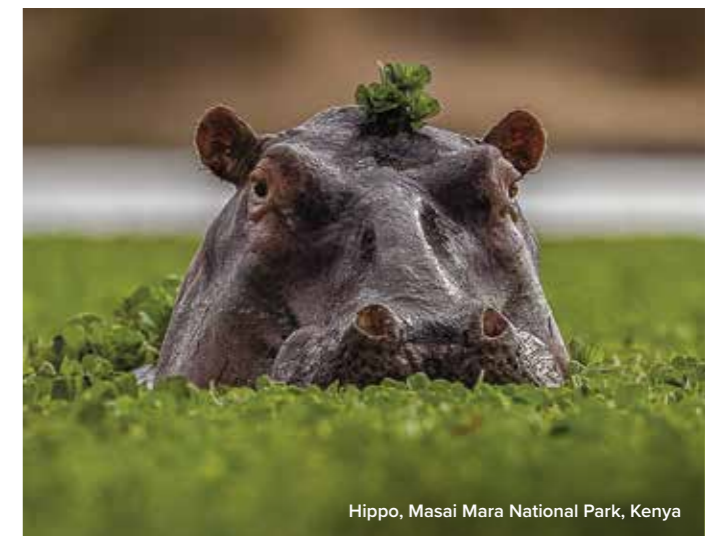

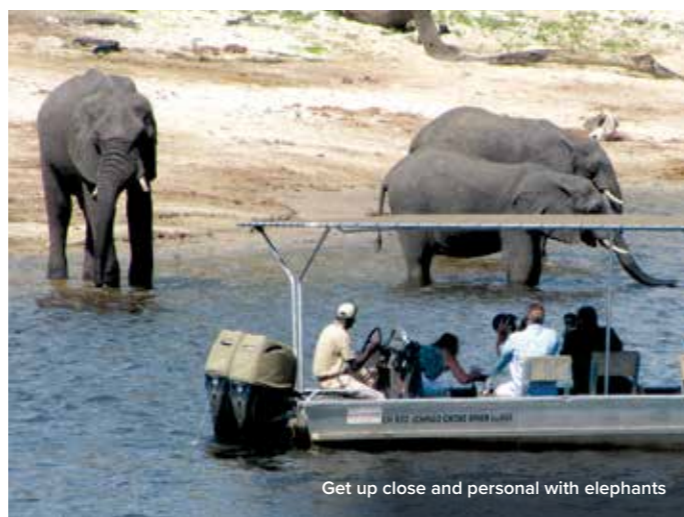
