Journey through Japan by rail

Travelling on a mix of local trains and shinkansen (bullet trains), this tour takes in the highlights of three of Japan's islands – Kyushu, Honshu, and Hokkaido while immersing you in history and tradition with a series of unique cultural experiences. It all starts in Fukuoka and Nagasaki on Kyushu before whizzing over to Honshu where your explorations will begin in Hiroshima followed by magnificent Himeji Castle, ancient Nara and the timeless charms of Kyoto, including a tea ceremony.



Marvel at the mountain scenery

Tales of the Silk Road are full of intrepid adventures, and that's exactly what you'll get on this tour. Strike into China's northwestern corner by train (and occasionally bus), watching out the window as you experience the extraordinary landscapes of Gansu and Xinjiang provinces, where you'll soak up culture heavily influenced by both the ancient trading route and the minority populations that call this area home.

Beginning in the easternmost terminus, Xian, travel west through the Silk Road cities of Lanzhou, Zhangye and Jiayuguan, where you'll walk on the western reaches of the Great Wall. 
